### **District Report Card...**

This year school districts and individual schools will again not receive a rating of 1-5 due to the change from using the OAKS tests to the new Smarter Balanced test given to students in grades 3-8 and 11. Students scoring a 3 or 4 meet

the standards for language arts and/or math and are determined to be on track to be college and career ready. Some of the highlights for the Spray School are:

- 70% met/exceeded state standards by scoring a 3 or 4 for language arts

- 78% met standards for writing on the district writing assessments
- Our graduation rate for students who attended Spray High School for two or more years is 100%.

Math remains the area with fewer students meeting the mark at 32%. Our focus for improvement will continue to be math this year. Teachers will be further implementing the Common Core State Standards in math and begin using new math curriculum materials. As a Title 1 school we provide additional time for math and literacy at all levels. ### **Athletics...**

The Eagle/Loggers volleyball team finished the season in last place. Myra Deltoso was recognized as honorable mention. The Rattler football team finished was also last in the league. It was a learning year for both teams. The fall awards dessert will be held Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> at 6pm in Mitchell. High School Basketball practice begins November 14th.

### **Conferences...**
